- Facilitate staff sharing sessions to build confidence and shared practices
- Provide model lessons demonstrating effective active teaching strategies clearly
- Establish simple whole-school routines supporting consistency across classrooms daily
- Encourage collaborative planning to strengthen implementation and shared understanding
